

VILLAGE OF LONGVIEW

BYLAW 382-16

BEING A BYLAW IN THE VILLAGE OF LONGVIEW IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO REPEAL BYLAWS WHICH HAVE BEEN SUPERSEDED BY SUBSEQUENT ENACTMENTS;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to and under authority of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M- 26 and amendments thereto, the Council of the Village of Longview, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26, Part 2, Division 1, grants Council general authority to pass bylaws ;

WHEREAS, there remain bylaws in the records of the Village that have been superseded by updated bylaws for the same purpose, but remain un-repealed;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Longview has deemed it desirable and necessary to establish consistency within the bylaws of the Village;

AND WHEREAS BYLAW 148- has been superseded by Bylaw 317-09;

AND WHEREAS BYLAW 167- has been superseded by bylaw 355-13;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Longview, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. TITLE

1.1 This Bylaw shall be cited as the Housekeeping Bylaw.

2. REPEAL

2.1 Bylaw 148 is hereby repealed.

2.2 Bylaw 167 is hereby repealed.

THIS BYLAW comes into full force and effect upon third and final reading.
