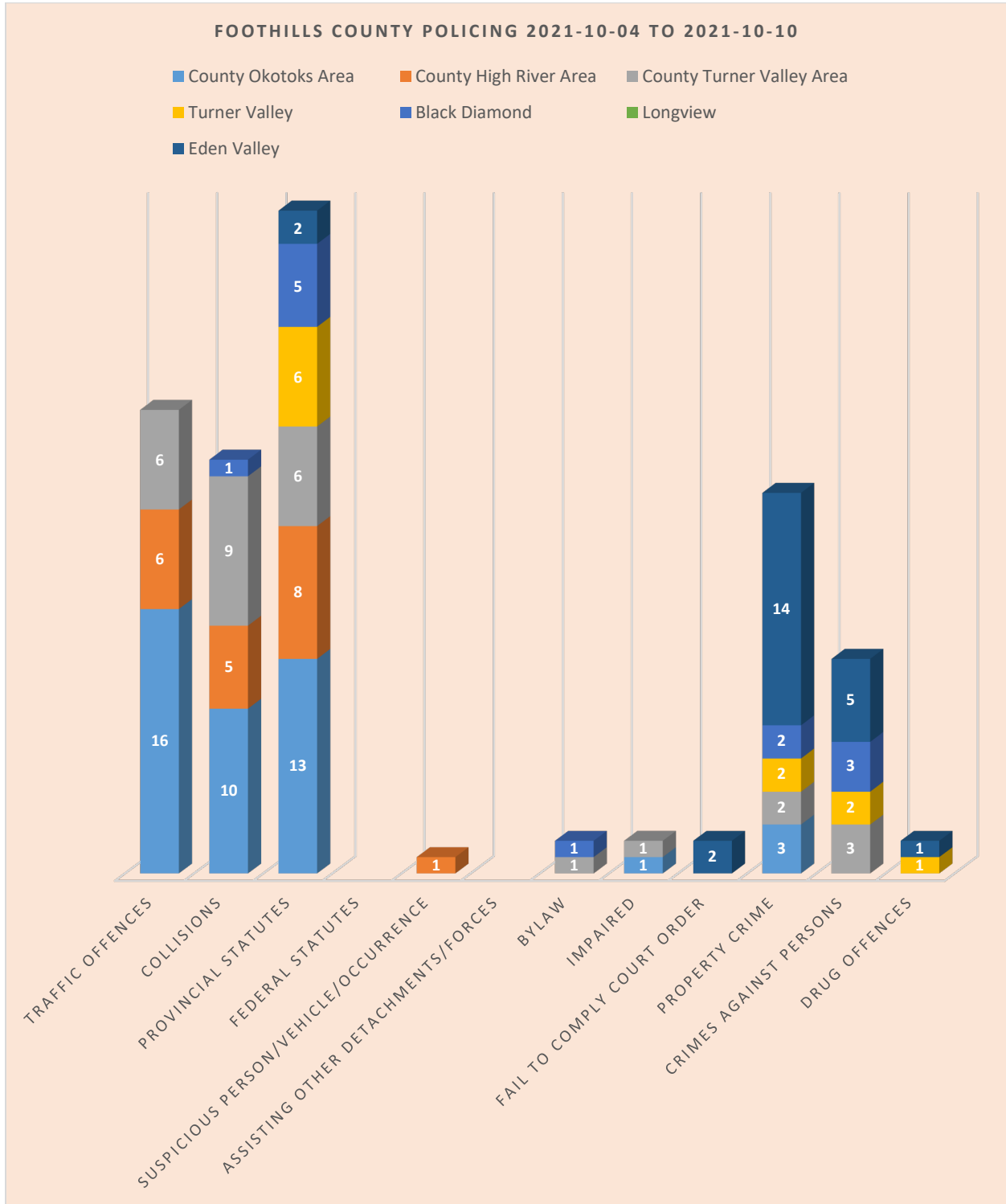

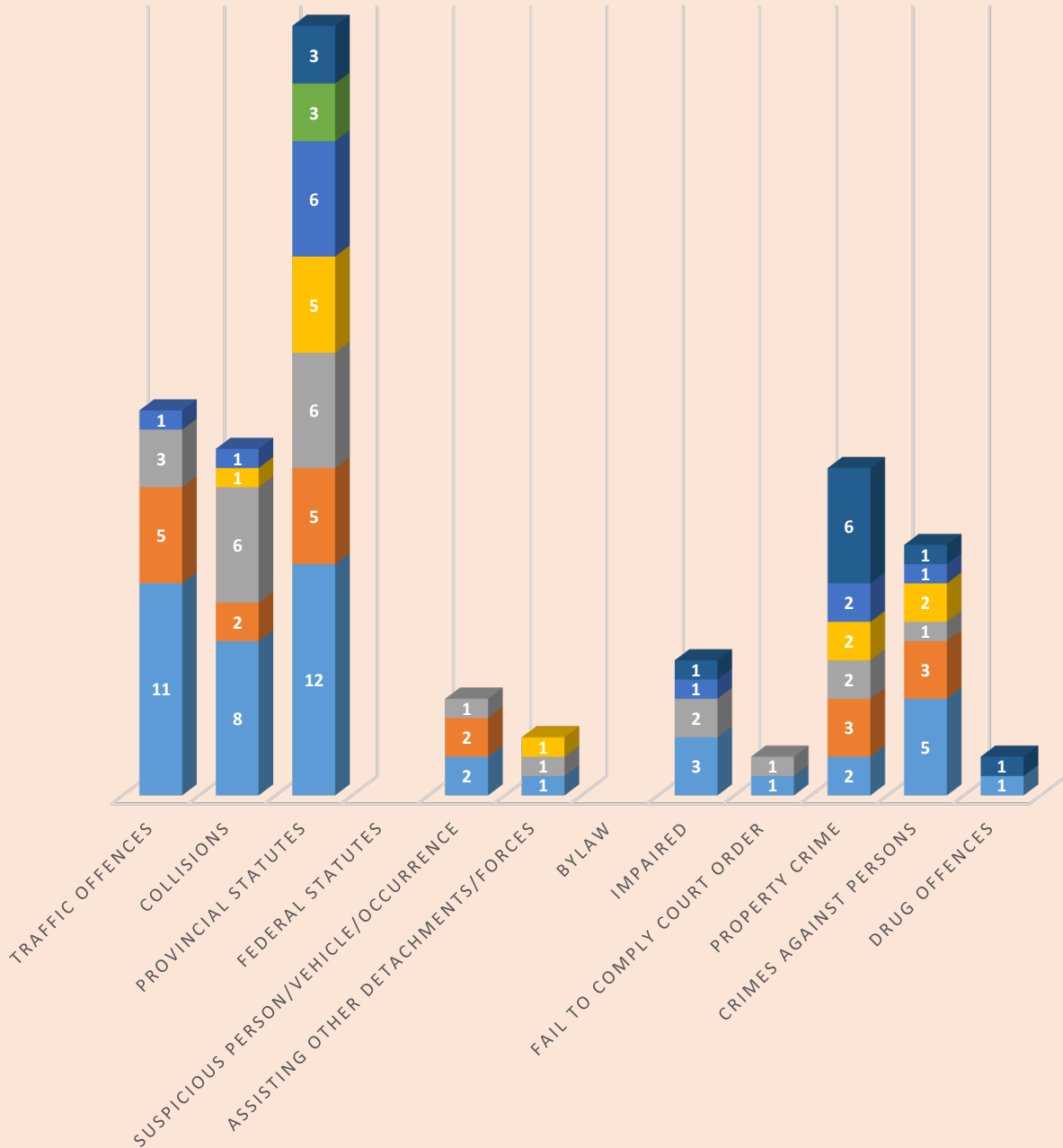

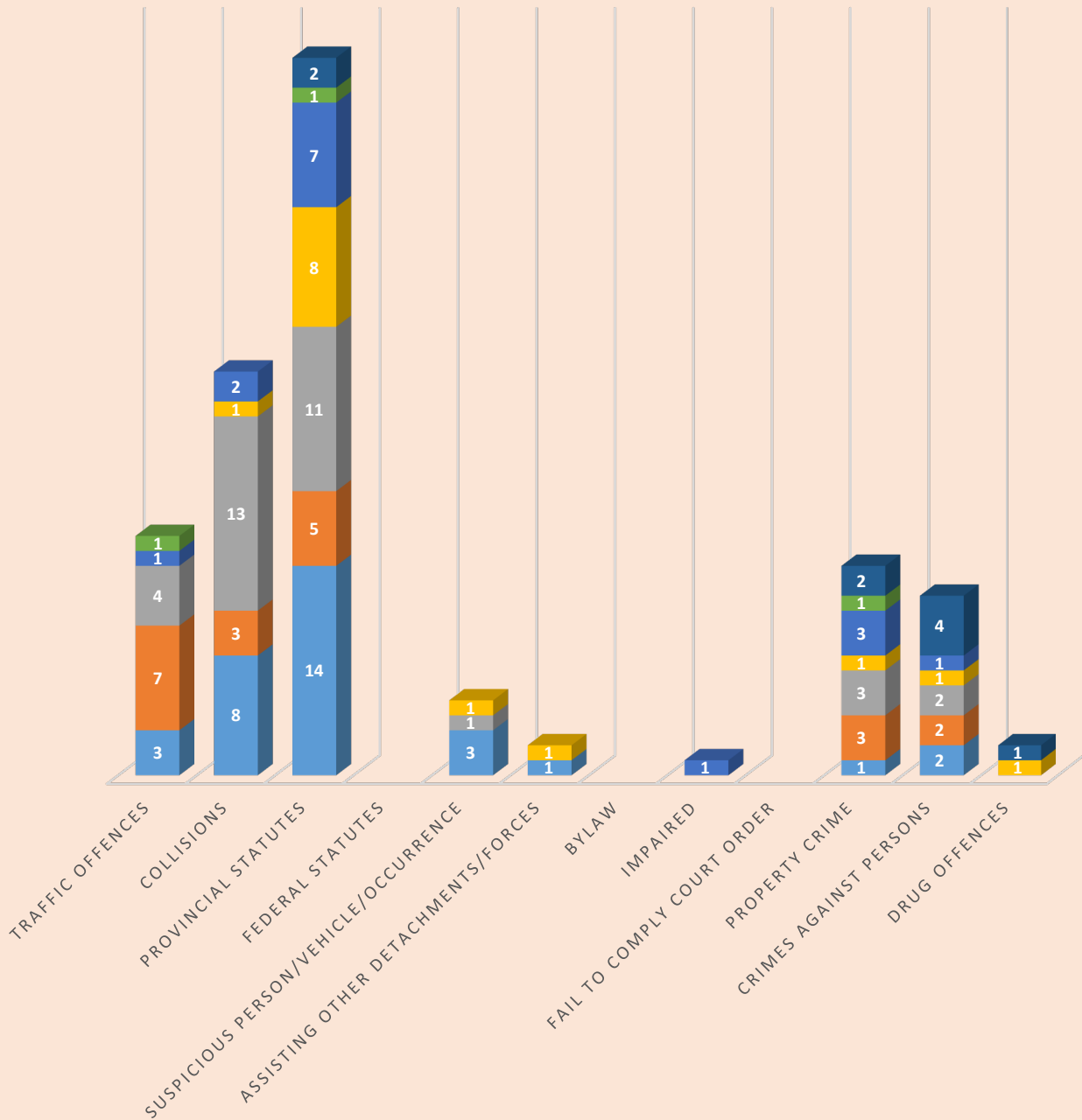

On October 14, 2021, at approximately 3:45pm, Foothills County RCMP responded to driving a complaint on Highway 22 West, Foothills County. Once on location a traffic stop was completed on the driver. The investigation revealed that the accused was under the influence of narcotics and had outstanding provincial arrest warrants. A 24-year old male from Edmonton was arrested on the outstanding warrants and received a 24-hour driving prohibition.

On October 14, 2021, Foothills County investigated an Assault, which occurred on 48 Street West, Foothills County. The investigation revealed that while attempting to gather cattle, an altercation occurred resulting in one male being assaulted. As a result a 71-year old male from Foothills County has been charged with Assault. He is set to appear in Okotoks Provincial Court on January 7, 2022 to answer to the charge.

On October 16, 2021, Foothills County RCMP were called to assist the Foothills County Peace Officers with a traffic stop on Heritage Pointe, Foothills County, as the driver was believed to be impaired. A MAS request was made of the driver, which resulted in a "fail". A 37-year old male from Calgary, Alberta was provincially suspended and his vehicle towed from the location.

On October 20, 2021 at approximately 2:50pm, Foothills County RCMP received a complaint of a vehicle hit and run in a parking lot on Centre Avenue in Black Diamond, Alberta. The investigation revealed that a truck drove into the parking lot, strikes a parked vehicle and then drives away. A witness to the incident was provided to RCMP. As a result of the investigation, a 22-year old male has been charged provincially with Fail to Ascertain Sufficient Space for Movement and received a \$162.00 fine.

Police would like to remind everyone, that when involved in any motor vehicle collision there is a responsibility on all involved to ensure vehicle information is exchanged at the time of the incident. If a property owner is not present or available a note advising of the incident should be left.

On October, 2021, at approximately 10:47am, Foothills County RCMP with the assistance of Okotoks RCMP responded to a robbery at a business in Heritage Point, Foothills County. Three males entered the business, forcibly confined 2 employees and a customer, made threats and stole an unknown quantity of goods. The suspects then fled the location in a gold 4-door sedan vehicle. No one was physically injured.

At approximately 10:00pm, Foothills County RCMP with the assistance of Calgary Police Service Tactical Unit (TAC), Calgary Police Service Robbery Unit, Southern Alberta District RCMP General Investigation Section (SAD GIS), Okotoks RCMP GIS, a search warrant was executed at a residence in the northeast area of Calgary, Alberta and two males were arrested.

Gabriel Keeling (18) of Calgary, Alberta has been charged with Robbery, Disguise with Intent, Forcible Confinement x 3, Mischief under \$5000 x2.

A 17-year youth has also been charged with Robbery, Disguise with Intent, Forcible Confinement x 3, Mischief under \$5000 x 2, Possession of a Controlled Substance – cocaine and Fail to Comply x4.

Both subjects are remanded into custody to appear in Cochrane Provincial Court on October 25, 2021 to speak to the charges.
