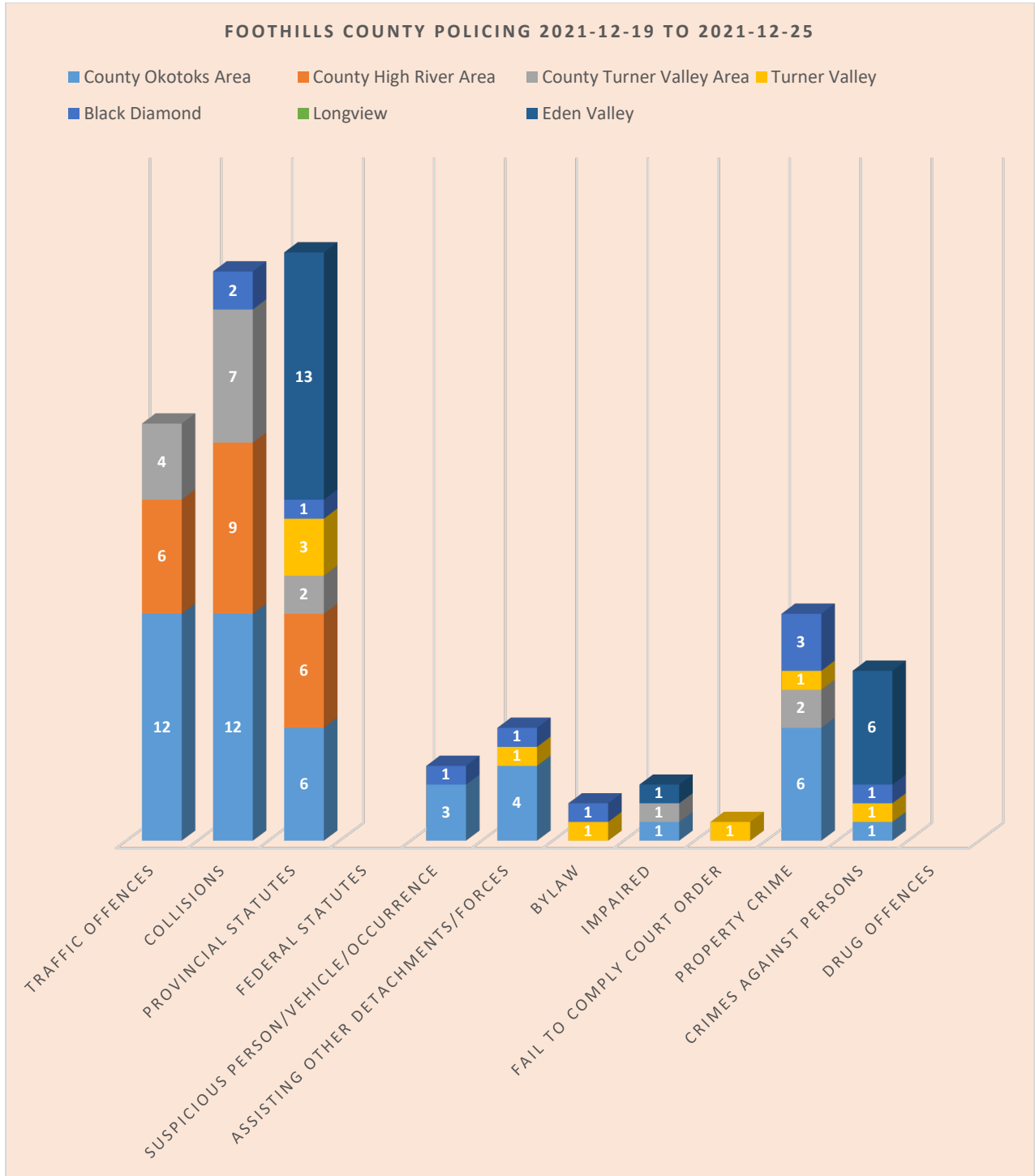

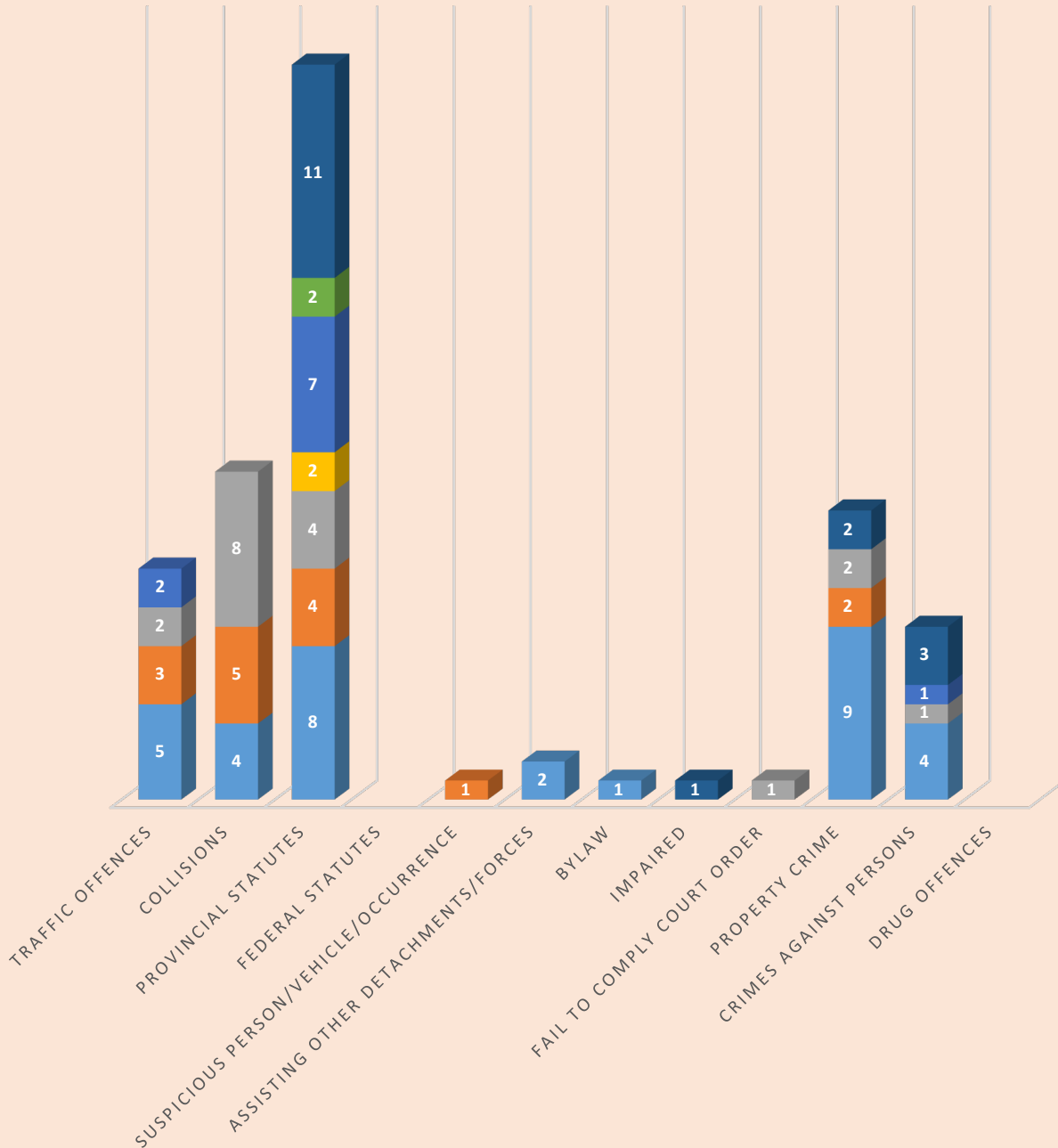

December 19, 2021, Foothills County RCMP responded to an assault complaint on Eden Valley First Nation, Foothills County. The investigation revealed while working on a vehicle an altercation occurred between two males, resulting with one of the males being hit in the face with a wrench. This matter is still under investigation and charges are pending.

December 20, 2021, Foothills County RCMP received an erratic driver complaint on Highway 22, Foothills County. RCMP located the vehicle and conducted a roadside traffic stop. During the investigation, the vehicle driver showed signs of Impairment. A 42-year old male from Turner Valley subsequently received a roadside driving suspension; his vehicle was towed from the location. The driver was also charged with following to close, contrary to Section 18(1) of the Use of Highways and Rules of the Roads Regulation, with a specified penalty of \$243.00.

December 21, 2021 at 0930 hrs, Foothills County RCMP responded to a vehicle Mischief complaint in Aldersyde, Foothills County. Video surveillance captured suspect(s) smashing a vehicle window then leaving the area once the car alarm sounded. This Criminal Code offence is still under investigation and charges are pending.

December 24, 2021, at approximately 1:15 pm Foothills County RCMP received several 911 calls of an erratic driver on Highway 2 northbound swerving all over the highway. While members were on route, the vehicle failed to slow down or stop for a vehicle stopped at the intersection of Dubow Road and Highway 2A, hitting it at highway speed. Both drivers were taken to a Calgary hospital with non-life threatening injuries. This matter is still under investigation.

December 25, 2021, Foothills County RCMP responded to an assault complaint on Eden Valley First Nation, Foothills County. As a result of the investigation, the suspect was charged with Assault. He was released from custody to appear in Turner Valley Provincial Court on March 22, 2022 to answer to the charge.

Sometime overnight on December 25, 2021, an unknown suspect vehicle drove thru a fence on Priddis Valley Road West, Foothills County, destroying approximately 40 feet of the fence at a value of approximately 6 to 8-thousand dollars. Pieces of the suspect vehicle were left at the location leading investigators to believe the suspect vehicle is a Chrysler truck. By law, anyone involved in a collision is required to exchange information with other property owners and if combined damage is over 2-thousand dollars a report to local police is required. If anyone has information regarding this offence, they are urged to contact the Foothills County (Turner Valley Detachment), or Crime Stoppers.

On December 28, 2021 at 1:30am Foothills County RCMP received a 911 call regarding a suspicious male wandering around Heritage Isle, Foothills County. The male was then observed to cut down the complainant's neighbour's tree in his yard putting on the hood of a vehicle. The suspect was located and arrested without incident by members. Colton Emery Knowles, age 25 of Calgary, Alberta has been charged with Wilful Damage to Property x3 and Possession of a Weapon Dangerous to the Public. He has been released from custody to appear in Okotoks Provincial Court on February 11, 2022 to answer to the charges.

On December 28, 2021, at 1:00am, unknown suspect(s) broke a window at the Red Deer Lake United Church gaining access inside. Video surveillance from the church was located, which identified three responsible males in a distinct sporty red sedan vehicle. This matter is still under investigation and anyone that may have information regarding this Criminal Code offence is urged to contact the Foothills County RCMP (Turner Valley) or Crime Stoppers.

On December 31, 2021 Foothills County RCMP obtained and executed a Search Warrant on a property on 2253 Drive East, Foothills County, following up on information of stolen property at that location. Seized from the location was a Ford F-150, Mercedes Benz C240, Toyota Corolla and a utility trailer, all of which were reported stolen. Other miscellaneous items were also seized. A male suspect has been charged with Possession of Property obtained by Crime x 5, Possess Forged Documents x 3 and Illegal Possession of Government Documents. A female suspect has been charged with Possession of Property obtained by Crime over \$5000.00. Both have been released from custody to appear in Okotoks Provincial Court on February 4, 2022 to answer to the charges.
