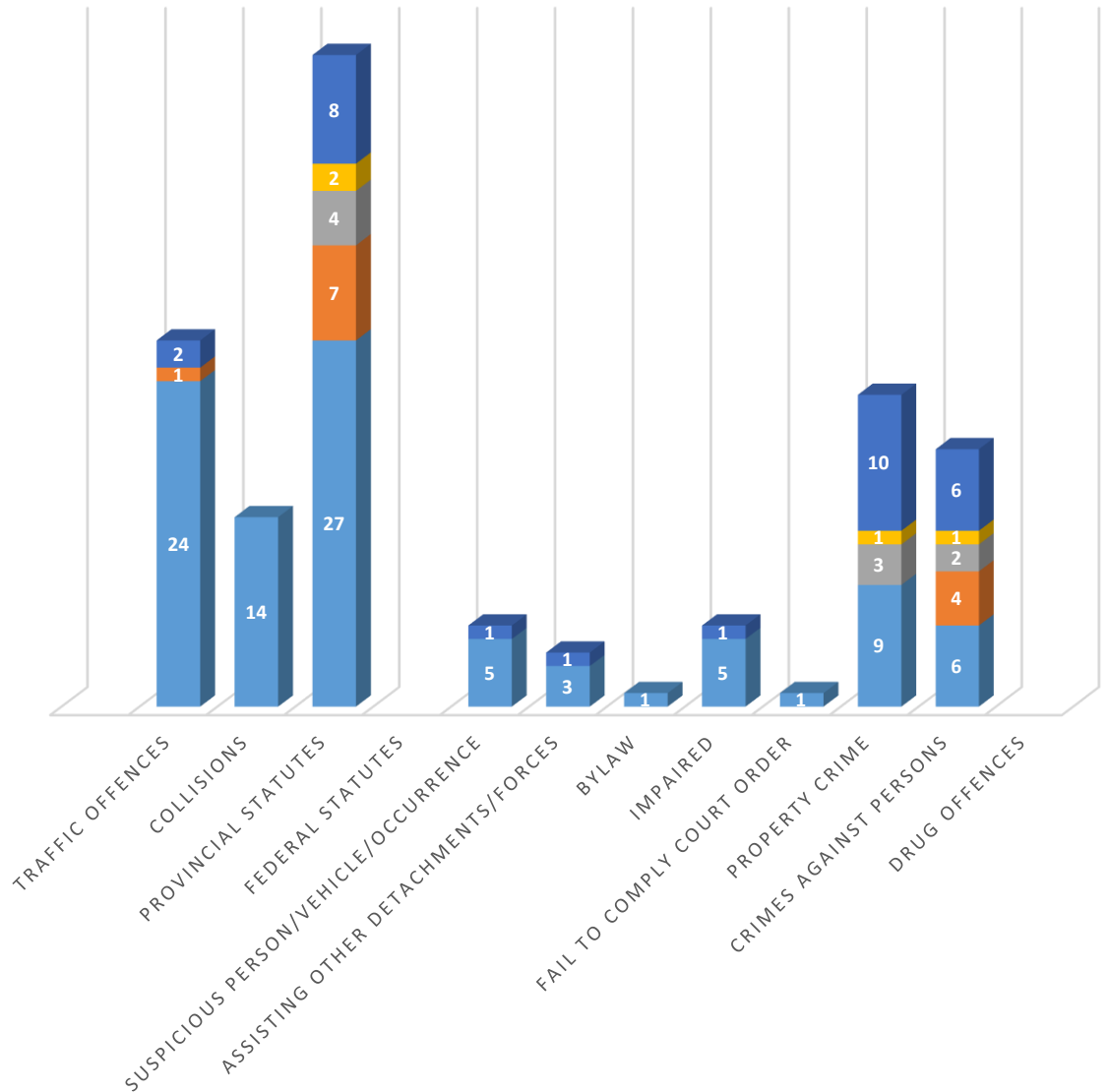

On August 3, at approximately 4:00pm, 2021 Foothills County RCMP responded to a Theft of mail complaint 272 Street West, Foothills County. The investigation revealed that the mailbox lock was drilled out. The accused person(s) were observed leaving the area in an older SUV, and this matter continues to be investigated. Anyone that may have information is asked to contact the Foothills RCMP (High River Detachment)

On August 8, 2021, at approximately 4:00 am unknown person(s) entered a property on Twin Cities Drive, Longview, Alberta and removed a catalytic converter from a Ford motorhome. There are no suspects at this time; however, a very loud vehicle was heard leaving the area at that time. If anyone has surveillance video in this area, or information regarding this Criminal offence they are asked to contact the Foothills County RCMP (Turner Valley Detachment)

On August 4, 2021, while conducting patrols of 48 street near 338 Avenue, in the Foothills County, RCMP observed a vehicle travelling 107 km an hour in a 60 km an hour zone. A Calgary, Alberta male has been charged with exceeding maximum speed limit established for highway and received a \$458 fine.

On August 7 2021 at 4:30 am while conducting a routine patrol of Highway 2 near 498 Avenue East, Foothills County RCMP observed a vehicle travelling at a high rate of speed. A traffic stop was conducted during which the vehicle driver displayed signs of impairment. A Mandatory Alcohol Screening (MAS) demand was given to the driver, which resulted in a fail on the ASD. A male from Calgary, Alberta received a Provincial roadside suspension.
