



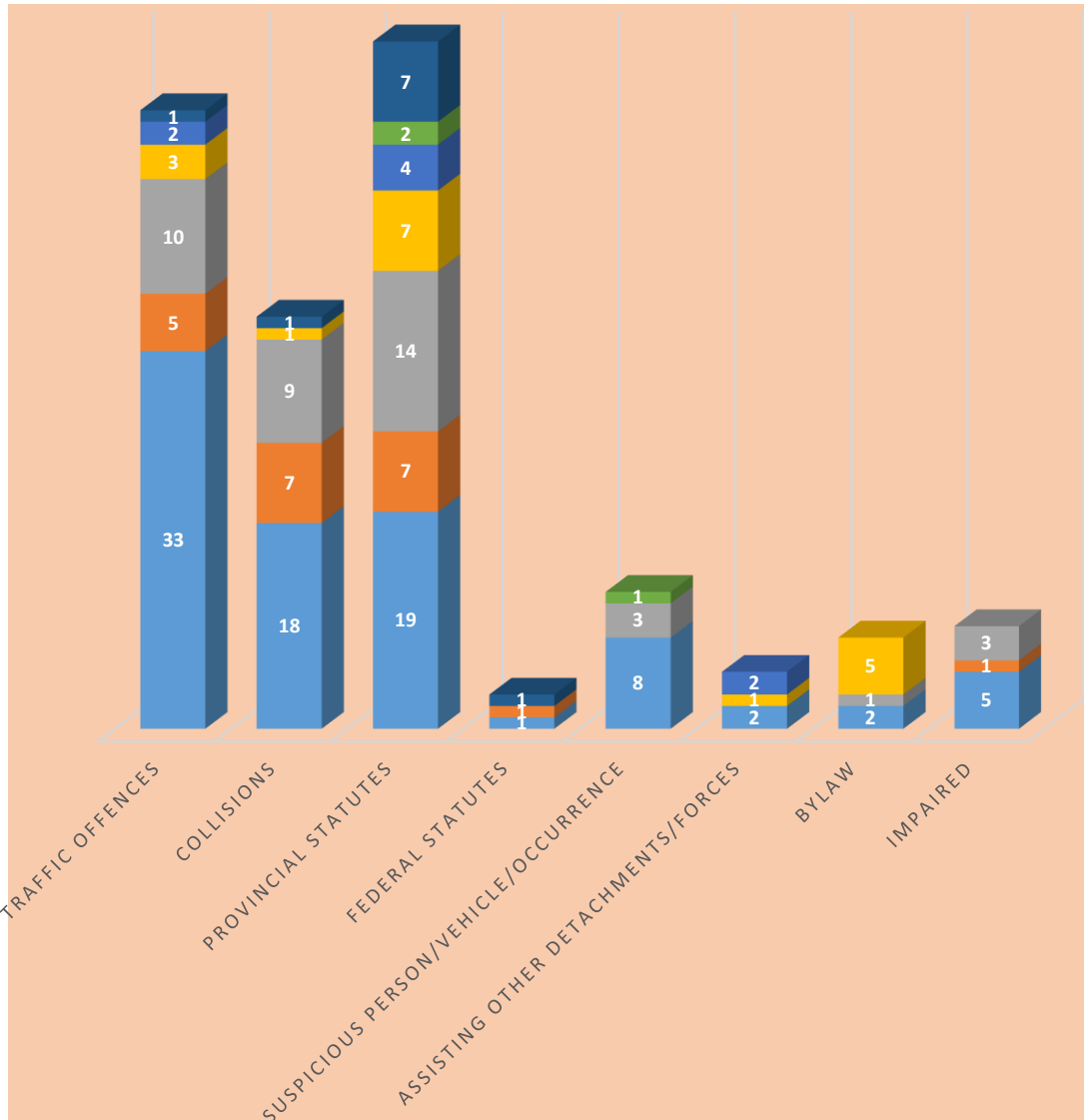

On September 2, 2021 at approximately 6:30pm, Foothills County RCMP responded to a male with a gun complaint on Eden Valley First Nation. The investigation revealed that the accused male had previously entered a residence and Bear Sprayed another male inside the residence. Dennis Lefthand, age 31 is facing numerous charges including Assault with a Weapon, Resisting a Peace Officer and numerous Fail to Comply with a Release Order. He has been remanded into custody to next appear in Turner Valley Provincial Court on September 21, 2021 to speak to the charges.

On September 4, 2021, Foothills County RCMP responded to a suspicious vehicle complaint in the Aldersyde Industrial area. The vehicle was located and as a result of the investigation, 114 grams of Methamphetamine, 110 grams of Cocaine and 93 grams of Fentanyl were seized. The vehicle driver was arrested for Breach of a Court Order in relation to a 24-hour house arrest condition, and two females occupants were also arrested on outstanding warrants.

Jay Bridgman age 50 of Calgary, Alberta, Samara Astalnok age 22 of Calgary, Alberta and Sarah Turner-Stewart age 22 of Calgary, Alberta are all facing charges of Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking x 3, Possession of Stolen Property over 5000. Bridgman is further charged with 3 counts of Fail to Comply with a Court order. Bridgman and Turner-Stewart have been remanded into custody to next appear in Okotoks Provincial Court on September 17, 2021 to speak to the charges. Astalnok has been released to appear in court on the same date to answer to the charges.

The Foothills RCMP, along with the Calgary Police Service are saddened to share that the remains of 68-year old Stanley STOOSHONOFF, a hiker who went missing in the Sandy McNabb area in June, have been located.

An extensive search was conducted at the time of Mr. STOOSHINOFF's disappearance and involved numerous organizations, including RCMP, CPS, Alberta Parks and Search and Rescue. Despite several days of dedicated effort, searches were unable to locate him.

Hunters in the area came upon human remains on Wednesday, September 8, 2021, and the Officer of the Chief Medical Examiner has since positively identified them as belonging to Mr. STOOSHINOFF. As the death is not considered suspicious, no further information will be shared.

Our thoughts go out to the family and friends of Mr. STOOSHINOFF.
