



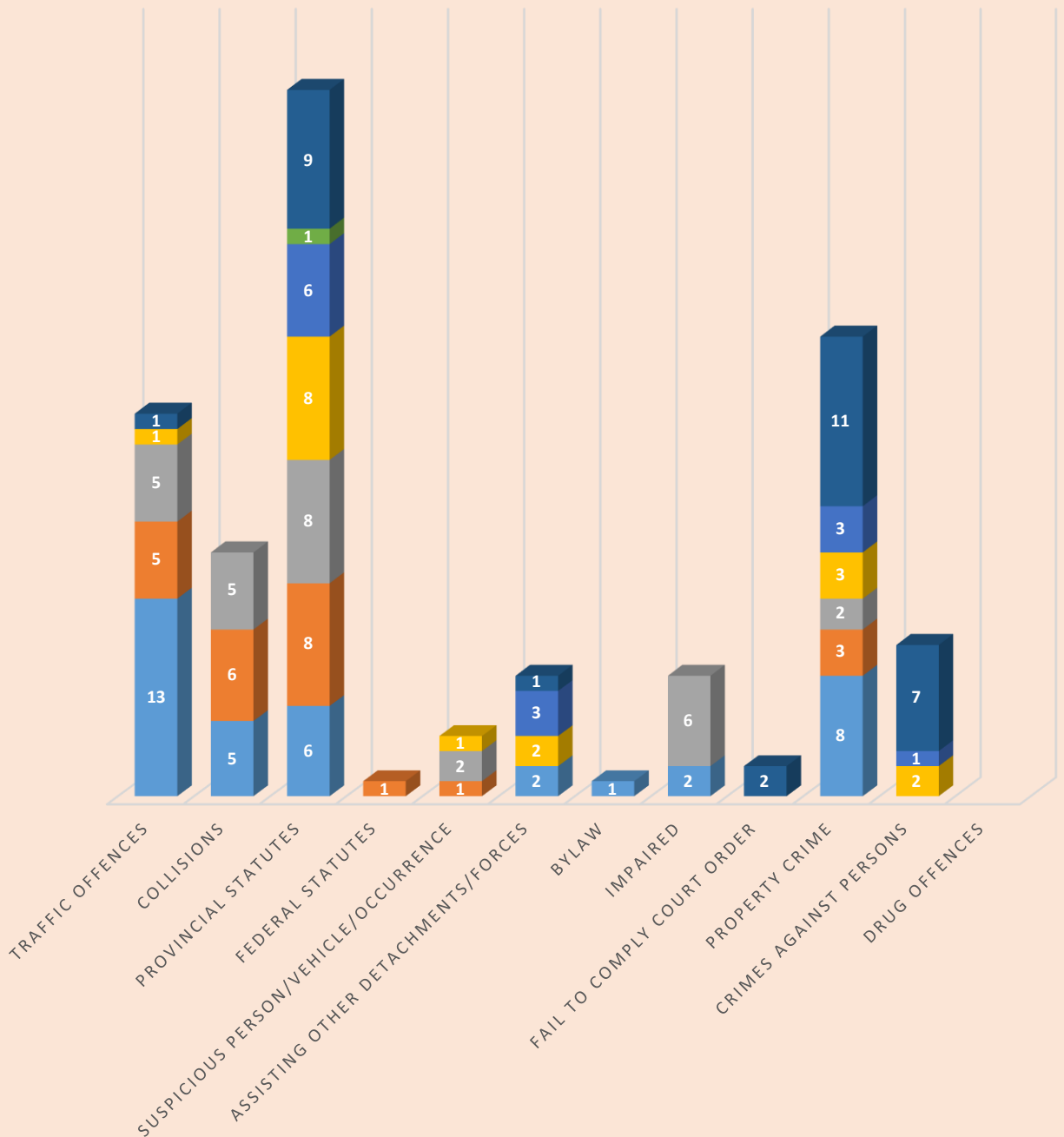

RCMP TURNER VALLEY DETACHMENT

On September 13, 2021, at 2:15 PM, Foothills County RCMP (Turner Valley) responded to a complaint of a grizzly bear walking in the alley on Edwards Avenue near the school in Turner Valley. The school was advised and all students were returned indoors. RCMP and CPO offers remained on location and monitored the bear until it left the area north of town. RCMP remind everyone to never approach wildlife in the town and to report any sightings to police or Fish and Wildlife.

On September 14, 2021, Foothills County RCMP received a complaint of a quad and trailer being stolen from a rural residence on 16 street, Foothills County. The quad and trailer were later recovered in Calgary, Alberta.

On September 15, 2021, a Foothills County residence, was researching for formation on his computer when he received a display on his screen to call Microsoft. The resident assumed it was a computer repair specialist and allowed him access to his computer. This resulted in an unknown individual gaining access to his personal banking information and cash was withdrawn. RCMP remind everyone to never allow anyone access to their electronic devices, and to ensure they protect their personal information.

On September 16, 2021, Foothills County RCMP (Okotoks) responded to a Break and Enter to a business on 393 Avenue East, Foothills County. The investigation revealed that unknown person(s) cut the business chain link fence gaining access to the compound and a catalytic converter was stolen from a Ford Motorhome. This Criminal Code offence of Break, Enter and Theft is still under investigation and anyone with information is urged to contact the Foothills County RCMP, Okotoks office, or Crime Stoppers.

On September 17, 2021, at 8:00am responded to a two vehicle MVC at the intersection of 434 Avenue East and Highway 783. One of the vehicles involved was traveling south on Highway 783, when another vehicle pulled out in front of the southbound vehicle at the intersection of 434 Avenue East. The southbound vehicle unsuccessfully attempted to manouver around the other vehicle hitting the front end. All three occupants of the two vehicles were transported by ground ambulance to hospital with non-life threatening injuries.
