



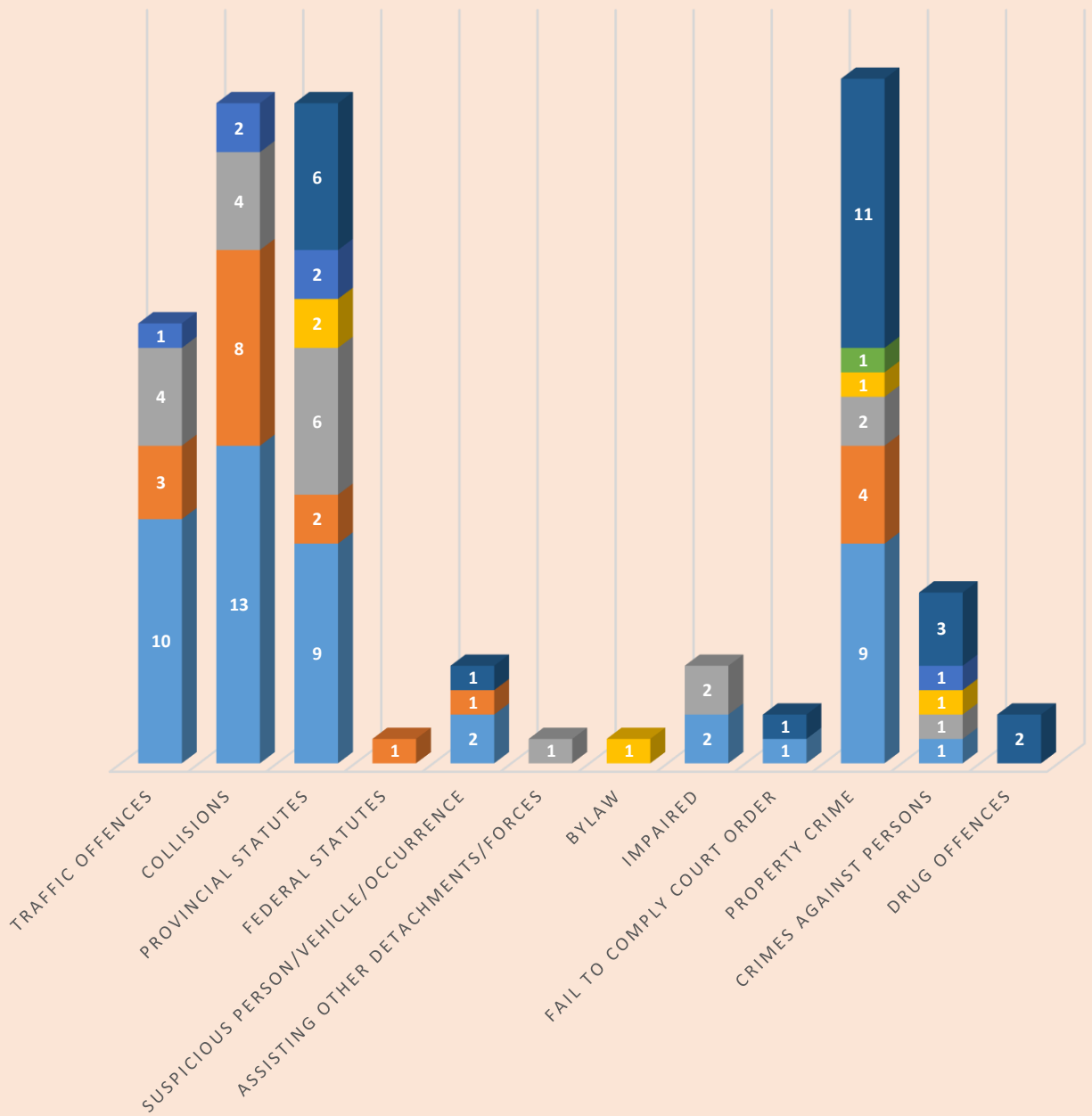

On January 10, 2022 at 8:00pm, Foothills County RCMP and Alberta Sheriffs responded to numerous 911 calls of a two vehicle MVC on Highway 2A near ABILD'S Industrial Park, Foothills County. Through the investigation it was learned that after the collision, a road rage incident occurred where one of drivers slashed the tires of the other drivers vehicle. Jordan Troy Bateman, age 23, of High River, Alberta has been charged with Criminal Mischief to Property. He has been released to attend Okotoks Provincial Court on February 25, 2022 to speak to the charge.

On January 13, 2022, Foothills County RCMP responded to a break and enter to a property on 2431 Drive East, Foothills County. Stolen from the property was a trailer, snow pusher and other items. This matter is still under investigation and if anyone has information, regarding this theft they are urged to contact the Foothills County RCMP (High River) or Crime Stoppers. If any resident owners along that area have video surveillance that is not currently registered with the CAPTURE program that would also be helpful information to move the investigation forward.

Sometime between January 7th and January 10, 2022, unknown suspect(s) entered a rural property of Highway 22 between Priddis and Highway 762, and vandalized several vehicles, causing extensive damage. Foothills County RCMP are urging anyone with information regarding this Criminal Code offence to contact the Foothills County RCMP (Turner Valley) or Crime Stoppers. If anyone who has video surveillance not currently registered with the CAPTURE program you are also asked to contact police as you may have evidence valuable to the investigation.

On January 13, 2022 at 10:00am, Foothills County RCMP responded to a deer caught in a metal pole fence near the Black Diamond Gallery in Black Diamond, Alberta. Once on scene, RCMP members were able to free the deer who happily ran away with only a bold spot.

Within this week Foothills County RCMP members responded to 9- Motor Vehicle Collisions involving wildlife and an additional 13 other motor vehicle collisions.
