Current opportunity for relocation former Gallery - \$750 a month
Deputy Mayor Lyons asked the Post Mistress if she had been in contact with Canada Post. Response was that Canada Post was not responding.

Current Post Office status - Grade Box based on revenue and volume

Eden Valley has a depot and pick up mail from Longview Post Office

Request that the Village lobby for a Corporate Office. A letter from Village to improve 1) Accessibility i.e. single level, 2) larger space, 3) more hours of service, 4) be converted to a corporate office. Village will be supplied with contact information to address letters.
